

West Port Said Container Terminal received first call of CMA-CGM New service MEREX

West Port Said Container Terminal received first call of new service MEREX MV "Charlie", the service fully operated by CMA-CGM. The ship was operated successfully with high handling rates reached 26 container / crane/ Hour.

The new service was launched on 25^{th} . of November, 2019, deploying (4)vessels linking Red Sea to Mediterranean, the weekly service offering direct link between four main hubs: Jeddah, Port Said, Malta, Tangiers with direct connection to Alexandria , West Africa via Tangiers.
