WEST PORT SAID CONTAINER TERMINAL SUPPORTS EQUIPMENT FLEET WITH (6) RTG CRANES



On June 27, 2019, West Container Terminal took delivery of (6) Rubber Tyred Gantry Cranes (Maximum Stable) manufactured by Shanghai Zhenhua Heavy Industry Co., Ltd. (ZPMC) at investment cost of 9 million USD with lifting capacity of 40 tons load each, 18.4m stacking height of 1 over 5 High Cube stacks and 26.5m stacking width (5 plus truck lane wide)

New RTGs will enter service directly as they supplied fully erected, so the terminal RTG fleet will be 28 to raise terminal capacity to meet fierce competition in the region.

The company is moving ahead with the development process and achievements in order to raise the company's position in the maritime market, hoping for further progress and development of this PSCCHC.
